STEP 6



Rewards

Score an average of 70% on all three tests to qualify for a grand trip!

STEP 7





Those who score an average of 70% through all 3 tests will be eligible to enter the grand championship, During the championship, they will take the final test on all of the material learned and be awarded JewQ medals based on their score.

The top scorers of each grade will be awarded a JewQ Trophy and a prize.

GRADE 3

You are not responsible for the Hebrew words of the prayers (pages 13, 35, 39, 44-48).

GRADE 4

You are only required to know the first two Pesukim (pages 50, 51) in Hebrew. For the rest of the Pesukim, it is enough to know the general meaning.

You are responsible for all of the Hebrew blessings except the ones on pages 87 and 88.

GRADE 5

You are responsible to know all the Hebrew blessings in the

Jewish Holidays section and the names of the Jewish months (page 99).

GRADE 6

You are responsible to know the Hebrew names of:

- The Five Books of the Chumash (page 177)
- > The Prophets (page 178)
- The Holy Writings (page 179)

You are not required to know the Hebrew names of:

- > The Six Books of the Mishna (page 181)
- > The Books of the Shulchan Aruch (page 182)

GRADE 7

You are not responsible to know which years each Jewish hero lived.
